FALL '11 SEMESTER

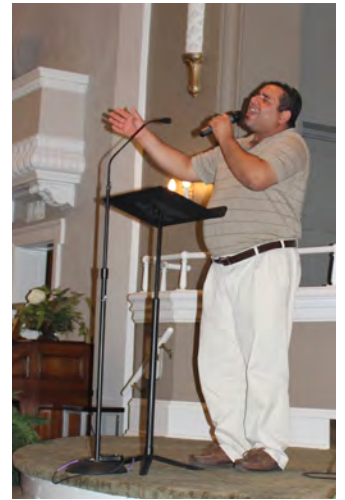
