Austin Work Team

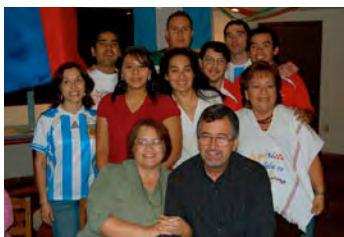
