## FALL 2010 ENROLLMENT

After a busy summer for faculty and staff, students have returned to campus. With 37 students registered in the Mexico Campus and 28 in Eagle Pass, the 2010 school year at Colegio Biblico began on August 24th. A total of 31 new students arrived this semester- 18 of them to Piedras Negras and 13 to Eagle Pass.

The convocation ceremony was held at the Mexico Campus after the first day of classes where President Jorge E. Mercado declared the school year officially begun. This year's new students at our Eagle Pass Campus come from Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Mexico and Texas. At the Mexico Campus the new students come from the states of Baja California, Coahuila, Guerrero, Mexico State, Oaxaca, and Yucatán. ## IN MEMORIAM

**Beryl Dean Cary**, went to be with the Lord on Friday, August 6, 2010, at the age of 69. Dean was the oldest son of Colegio's founders, Harland and Frances Cary. He served as President of Colegio Biblico from 1976 to 1981. Dean graduated from Eagle Pass High School in 1959. He also graduated from Ozark Christian College with a B.S.L. in 1964 and a B.A. in Theology in 1965. From 1968-1970, he did graduate work in Latin American History at the University of the Americas in Mexico City. Dean loved and served the Lord faithfully and spent most of his life preaching and ministering to the Latin-American people.
