Work Teams on Campus

During the month of March, we had two work teams come down to Colegio. On March 16-21, Dan Provines from Wheatland Christian Church, in Wheatland, Indiana, led a group of 15. They installed the sheetrock in Duplex #1 and distributed groceries, toys and clothes around the neighborhood.

From the 21st to the 28th, David Embree from Missouri State University Christian Campus House, in Springfield, Missouri, led a group of 97 students! They split up in smaller groups and worked on several projects. About 50 of the students stayed at Colegio. They installed mud for the sheetrock on Duplex #1. For Duplex # 2, they framed the walls, built 37 trusses and installed 13 of them. For Duplex #3 they dug trenches for the foundation, mixed concrete by hand for the foundation beams, did the plumbing, and filled and compacted to prepare for the concrete slab. The team also worked on a new staff house installing tile floor and soffit, and wiring the house to connect it to the power company. They also installed the soffit on a second staff house. In Eagle Pass, the kitchen crew sanded and painted 15 exterior doors. The rest of the Campus House students collaborated in three churches in Piedras Negras and with Vida Nueva ministries on several projects. Our gratitude to these work teams for the time and energy they invested in our ministry. God bless you!
